# A. Approval of Minutes and Treasurer's Report

- c. Remove \$950.00 from Travel Budget
- d. Remove \$150.00 from Advertising
- e. Remove \$9,000.00 from Land Purchase for Depot
- f. Remove \$250.00 from Misc Expense
- g. Remove \$200.00 from Zoning Expense
- h. Increase Matching Sidewalk Grant to \$3,000.00
- i. Police Salaries decrease \$2,100.00
- j. Add line item for Retirement \$ 1600.00
- k. Decrease Misc Police Expense to \$500.00
- I. Remove \$1700.00 from Street Dept lights
- m. Remove \$250.00 from Misc Street Dept
- n. Remove \$1,000.00 from Park Maintenance
- o. Remove \$700.00 from Misc Park

The balance of all monies removed minus monies added will go back into the General Fund Expense.

Merge the Sales Tax and Franchise Tax plus increase \$12,000 from the two items and reduce the General Fund Expense by this amount also.
