Commissioner Walker made the motion to adjust the Appropriated Funds \$20,000 in the Budget, Commissioner Ed Walker 2nd the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Brunch Bill

This tabled discussion was revisited tonight. Mayor Pro Tem Neef made a motion to allow the sale of alcohol at 10:00 am, the only portion of the Town's Alcoholic Ordinance that will change will be the time of the day on Sunday that alcohol can be sold. Commissioner Ed Walker 2nd the motion. This motion did not pass unanimously. Commissioner Auman- Nay, Commissioner Sandra Walker- Nay, Commissioner Pam Allen- Absent, Mayor Pro Tem Neef- Yay, Commissioner Ed Walker- Yay This is a 2 to 2 tie, the Mayor voted to break the tie. His vote- Yay

Sidewalk Grant Update

The next meeting will be held on April 16th at 5:00. A motion was made by Commissioner Sandra Walker to have the "Official Opening of the New Town Hall" to coincide with the Sidewalk Steering Committee. Commissioner Auman 2nd the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
