E. New Business

It was also suggested that the Troop would be putting a sign to show that there is a campsite at the Park. Commissioner Sandra Walker made a motion to allow the troop to move forward with their project and Mayor Pro Tem Barbara Luther 2nd the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

RCEDC presented their annual report. The Town was thanked for the participation with the EDC. Report is attached.

The clerk will start the annexation of the portion of the Luck's plant to be fully in the Town's limits.

A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Barbara Luther for the Town Clerk to adjust the budgeted funds for \$3000 out of the land purchase to be allocated to Garris Designs for the Depot and to reallocate police funds into the needed line item. Commissioner Cindy Neef 2nd the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Pam Allen to keep the Prohibited Uses and do away with the Building and Zoning Guidelines and Commissioner Jason Auman 2nd the motion. The motion carries.

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor David Fernandez. Those present were Mayor David Fernandez, Commissioner Sandra Walker, Commissioner Pam Allen, Commissioner Cindy Neef, Commissioner Jason Auman, and Mayor Pro Tem Barbara Luther.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive public input on the Town's application for an Economic Development Grant on behalf of Sapona Plastics with the help of the Randolph County Economic Development Corporation.

Bonnie Renfro spoke on behalf of the RCEDC. She stated that Sapona Plastics has rented space for the last couple of years in the old Luck's Plant due to their growing business. They have also successfully placed a bid on the old plant and will begin renovating very soon. Sapona Plastics will match dollar for dollar of the \$250,000 commerce grant being applied for and the Town would have to be the applicant for this grant. The Town and Randolph County are being asked to share a 5% donation towards the grant and the Town's portion will be \$6,250.

Sapona Plastics is also requesting voluntary annexation in to the Town of Seagrove limits.

Commissioner Sandra Walker made a motion to close the Public Hearing and Commissioner Cindy Neef 2nd the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
