## I. Sidewalk Contract with County

Randolph County Board of Commissioners have approved funding for the Downtown Seagrove sidewalks - \$108,000. We are in the process of procuring bids for the project and discussion of additional sidewalk/crosswalk patterns to account for the additional businesses that have arrived in Seagrove since our original assessment. Planning to have the project started in Spring 2022.

#### J. Train Depot Land Discussion

We are still working with the newly appointed representatives for the land adjacent to the Train Depot. Town attorney to meet with them to start discussions.

## K. Luck's Advisory Committee Recommendations

Contractor Bids – the advisory committee recommends we hire a contractor to oversee/manage the remainder of the project.
