SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
July 21, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Edmonds. Commissioners in attendance were: Pam Allen, Ruby Mullin, Barbara Luther and Jason Auman. Commissioner Jodi Sapper was absent.

**A. Public Hearing**

The motion was read as follows: FRESH CUTS OF SEAGROVE, INC. of Asheboro, NC is requesting a Sign Variance for four (4) small signs to be constructed on the building at the new Fresh Cuts Grocery Store to be located at 157 N. Broad Street in the Town of Seagrove.


The sign ordinance currently reads one wall and one suspended sign per occupant per street frontage wall. Wall sign should not exceed 10% of occupants' street frontage area.

There was a lengthy discussion about whether or not these signs meet the criteria of the ordinance. The board then contacted the store owner and asked him if he would be willing to connect the four signs in question. Kevin agreed to this. There was no opposition to this variance from the Town.


